

NEW BERN has been around for over 300 years, so whether you're a history buff, a day tripper, or just want to enjoy a mix of outdoor activities, this charming town has something for everyone.



TRYON PALACE

At Tryon Palace, North Carolina's history is more than a story...it's an experience. You can participate in a living history like no other—one that uniquely blends cutting-edge technology with events, experiences, and tools of centuries past. Immersive encounters and learning adventures abound for the whole family. ATTMORE-OLIVER HOUSE

This home, built circa 1790, exhibits 18th and 19th-century furniture and new Bern historical objects including Civil War artifacts. BIRTHPLACE OF PEPSI

At this spot in his pharmacy, Caleb Bradham invented "Brad's Drink," which was later patented as Pepsi-Cola. Today, you can purchase a souvenir, or relax and enjoy a Pepsi-Cola at the recreated soda fountain. Located at 256 Middle St., (252) 636-5898, www.PepsiStore.com, FREE

Seven restored aircrafts on loan from the U.S. Marine Corps and Department of Navy are on display, along with scaled models depicting the aircraft lineage of the 2D Marine Aircraft Wing at MCAS Cherry Point from its inception in 1942. Historic photographs and artifacts from Indian settlements to Civil War history round out the exhibit. Havelock

Just DOWN THE ROAD from New Bern in Craven county, Havelock is home to MCAS Cherry Point.



Havelock is one of eight cities in the world named for Sir Henry Havelock, two of which are in Canada, three in the United States; one in Swaziland (Southern Africa) and two in New Zealand. An island in the Indian Ocean is also named for him. Settled before the Revolutionary War, Havelock welcomed the United States Marine Corps in 1940. Today, visitors are often seen craning their necks as Harriers or a Prowler streaks by overhead. Local residents are used to the roar acknowledged by a sign near the base's main gate, which reads: "Pardon our Noise; It's the Sound of Freedom."

AVIATION EXHIBIT AT THE HAVELOCK TOURIST & EVENT CENTER

Discover an exciting exhibit, highlighting over 100 years of aviation in Eastern North Carolina. Seven restored aircrafts on loan from the U.S. Marine Corps and Department of Navy are on display, along with scaled models depicting the aircraft lineage of the 2D Marine Aircraft Wing at MCAS Cherry Point from its inception in 1942. Historic photographs and artifacts from Indian settlements to Civil War history round out the exhibit. 




